## Category: Arts, Music, Theatre

### KidzArt: Parent/Child

### Close-Up Nature Photography

This course focuses on close-up and macro photography in nature and is intended for anyone who wants to capture the intricacies of the world around us. The course is applicable to users of both film and digital SLR cameras that allow manual exposure settings or allow changes to the automatically determined exposure (exposure compensation). The student's camera should support interchangeable lenses. A dedicated macro lens is not required, but may be helpful. Students should have an understanding of how their cameras work and a basic understanding of exposure. The class will discuss equipment used for close-up photography, proper exposure, and techniques for sharp images.
